Could you use some help?

In 2005, the Rescue Riders were created to provide a “hands on” approach to directly help address the sobering statistics of rising motorcycle related deaths. Since that time, our Rescue Rider volunteers have logged thousands of miles supporting events like yours with our “Ride for a Reason®” program. Our volunteers provide emergency medical assistance to accident victims during The Golden Hour: In the world of emergency care, the “Golden Hour” is defined as the time period of about one hour in which the lives of a majority of critically injured trauma patients can be saved if definitive trauma care intervention is provided. This principle of rapid intervention can also be applied to non-trauma patients such as those having a heart attack or a stroke, in which time to treatment dramatically affects a patient’s outcome.

We are currently filling in our 2012 “Ride for a Reason®” support calendar and would like to know if you would again be interested in having our volunteer Rescue Riders “First Responders” support your event this year. If you are not going to be the coordinator for this year’s event(s), please forward this on to the proper person?

What’s the catch?

Our volunteers participate in your event just like any other attendee. We pay for our individual admissions and ride with other participants. In the event of an accident or injury during the ride, our Rescue Rider volunteers will provide emergency medical aid based upon the individual’s training and comfort level, bridging the critical time gap between the accident and EMS arrival if needed.

Once we receive your Event Support Request Form we will contact you to let you know if we have adequate resources to support your run. We try to support as many runs/events as possible. That’s it in a nutshell. If you would like for us to help provide support to your event please complete our Rescue Riders Event Support Request Form as our dates are already filling up fast. If we are able to support your run/event, a mission coordinator will be assigned and we will post the details of your event on our discussion forums event calendar to help you promote your event.
